

- It was built in the middle of 15th century.

- It is the central square in Ljubljana

## TRIPLE BRIDGES

• is a group of three bridges across the Ljubljanica River



#### LJUBLJANA TOWN HALL AND THE ROBBA FOUNTAIN

- It was built in 15 century
- There was a fountain before the town hall in the 16th century already. In 1751 it was replaced by "Fountain of the Three Rivers' by sculptor Francesco Robba (1698-1757).



## SLOVENE PHILLHARMONIC ORCHESTRA



- It was established in year 1701
- It was made by famous Slovene architect Jože Plečnik:



#### TIVOLI PARK

- •It was made in year 1813 by French engineer Blanchard
- In the park there are a pond, a botanical garden, a greenhouse, a playground, a spa, a sports hall Tivoli, teniss; basketball courts, skating and the mini golf
- It has a lot of walking paths, flowers, fountains and statues

#### DRAGON BRIDGE

- The bridge was
   originally named The
   Jubilee Bridge of the
   Emperor
- In July 1919, it was renamed to Dragon Bridge



#### KONGRESNI TRG SQUARE WITH STAR PARK

 The square was built in year 1821, Star Park in 1984

 monument anchor in memory of the annexation to the Motherland








#### CENTRAL MARKET

- Desined by Jože Plečnik
- The market is opened daily except Sundays

# THE KRIŽANKE COMPLEX

- is a theatre
- It was created by Jože Plečnik in year 1950








## BOTANICAL GARDEN

- It was created in year 1810
- Is the oldest botanical garden in Southeastern Europe
- And one of the oldest cultural, scientific, and educational organisations in Slovenia



#### CANKAR HALL

- It is the largest Slovenian convention
- designed by the architect Edvard Ravnikar and was built between 1977 and 1982
- the center is named after the Slovene writer, and socialdemocratic politician Ivan Cankar (1876–1918)









# SLOVENIAN NATIONAL THEATRE OPERA AND BALLET LJUBLJANA

- Is an opera house
- it was built between 1890 and 1892
- it has statues









# STOŽICE STADIUM

- is a multi-purpose stadium
- is the home ground of the football club Olimpija Ljubljana
- It was built in year 2010







#### BUTCHER'S BRIDGE WITH LOCKS LOVERS

- Is a footbridge crossing the river Ljubljanica
- it connects the Ljubljana Central Market and the Petkovšek Embankement
- it was created by architect Jože Plečnik









#### SKYSCRAPER
